HOLLY RIDGE UPDATE

The Town continues to grow rapidly and work to improve infrastructure and facilities for the citizens and stakeholders. The Town recently hired Police Chief Michael Sorg, Jr. and once restrictions are lifted due to COVID, there will begin to be meet & greets for the public to talk with Chief Sorg.

The Town is also working with Withers Ravenel to develop to Town's first Master Park Plan! There will be opportunities for the public to voice their wants and concerns in the coming future.



RECENT PROGRESS

- Recently awarded \$10,000 of \$46,000 from Duke Energy towards restoring the Morris Landing Preserve Living Shoreline.
- Expenses in the amount of approximately \$77,000 are eligible to be reimbursed by the Cares Act this year.
- 10 of the 12 lots in the Camp Davis Industrial Park have been sold. With the most recent announcements including the Grand Opening of Onslow Bay Boatworks, the Groundbreaking of Crete Solutions, and the announcement of the relocation of Atlantic Seafood.
- Since 2016 the Town of Holly Ridge's tax evaluation has increased by \$127,740,000.
- The Towns of Surf City and Holly Ridge will be holding the first drive-in Halloween Movie Night with a Car Decorating Contest with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes being awarded! The movie showing is Hocus Pocus!
- Extra Credit Grant Program : Most NC families with children are eligible for a \$335 COVID relief payment to help with the costs of virtual schooling/childcare costs.
